

This is quite a simple and enjoyable walk that passes a few nice pubs on the way. Unfortunately there is a small noisy section alongside the M25, but the remainder of the walk is quite idyllic. It is pretty easy to follow and can be shortened at quite a few points. It can be simply done in either direction.

Travel by car; There are plenty of parking possibilities around Chorleywood Common, but only pay and display near the station. There is parking for the woods near (6), and in the general area of The Stag Pub.

- 1) Exit station on N side (London bound), take footpath up through flats onto open common with golf course. Follow southern edge to pass nearby Black Horse pub, then under railway (2) and path to side of M25 motorway.
- (3) Turn R on slightly rising farm track, then at end turn L and follow road then track and path to Farm. At Bullsland Farm turn L onto trackway which descends and bends around to woodland.
- (4) Enter Woodland Trust woods to follow various paths, make sure to turn sharp R (5) and return to N part of woods.
- (6) Join Old Shire Lane, which then becomes a busy road with pavement path that descends back to village.
