This is a fabulous walk that enjoys many of the beauty spots on the River Chess. It passes 6 very good pubs - so the walk may take considerably longer. Some tricky parts to navigate, but you are unlikely to get lost.

1) Exit station on N side (London bound), take footpath up through flats onto open common with golf course.

Cross main road the take track down to river Chess and walk upstream.

- 2) Popular parking spot low in valley. Steep hill up to Church End.
- (3) Pass the Cricketters Pub on your left, then a narrow path. Views at Dellfield Farm are particularly nice.
- (4) Chipperfield has the Two Brewers pub opposite the cricket pitch, easy to follow roads to The Plough.
- (5) Footpath/track junction make sure to head south. This then descends to river Chess with watercress farm and ice cream sales at Mount Wood. Lovely lowland path with walkboards.
- (6) Ascent to Chenies Manor, then popular footpaths leading to houses of Little Chalfont.
